Whereas the University of Kerala has notified as per Notification read (1) above, for Bye-election to Senate of the University to fill up the existing vacancies including Four Members of the Legislative Assembly of Kerala from among members representing electorate of the University area, of whom one shall be a member of a Scheduled Caste, under Section 17, Elected Members (3) of the Kerala University Act, 1974, and;

Whereas the number of candidates validly nominated and not withdrawn, vide notification (2) above, were less than the number of vacancies to be filled by the election, under Statute 41 of the Kerala University (Conduct of Election to various Authorities or Bodies) First Statutes, 1974, that all the three Members of the Legislative Assembly of Kerala included in the said notification have been declared duly elected unopposed to the Senate of the University of Kerala, vide notification (3) above.

Meanwhile Sri. C.R Mahesh MLA, submitted an election petition on 30.11.2021 vide paper read as (4) above, against the rejection of nominations filed in his favour. In compliance with the judgment in WP (C) 28148/2021 read as paper (5) above, the Vice Chancellor conducted a hearing on 31.12.2021. As per the proceedings of the hearing referred (6) above, the Vice Chancellor has ordered to accept the nomination submitted by Sri. C.R Mahesh MLA, and to proceed accordingly.

Hence, it is hereby notified under Statute 33 and 41 of the Kerala University (Conduct of Election to various Authorities or Bodies) First Statutes, 1974, that **Sri. C.R Mahesh, Member, Legislative Assembly (Karunagappally), Chempakasseril, Thekkumurimekku, Thazhava P.O., Kollam - 690 523**, has also been declared duly elected unopposed to the Senate of the University of Kerala with effect from 17.01.2022.

The above member shall hold office in the Senate subject to the provisions contained in the Kerala University Act, 1974, and the Statutes framed there under.
