**Guidelines for awarding Grace Grade for Sports Performance from the Academic year 2010-11**

- The award of Grade Point for meritorious candidates is divided into 5 categories namely A, B, C, D & E. The maximum Grade Points that may be awarded to a student in a particular year for highest performance may be limited to 30 WGP. Further a limit of Cumulative WGP upto each category is also suggested so that justice is done for higher performance.
  - In case of both semester courses and annual courses, the academic year may be taken from 1<sup>st</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> May.
  - Grace Credit Points and corresponding WPGA should be distributed either in a semester or among the 2 semesters in an academic year as the calendar of Association of Indian Universities Competitions are held on a yearly basis.
  - The student shall claim the Grace Credit Points within 6 months after the end of the academic year.
  - Grace Credit Points and WPGA can be used for additional change / repeat of semester and for readmitted / N + 1 candidate as per AIU Guidelines.
  - The WPGA obtained by the student may be distributed to courses in a semester or among two semesters according to the choice of the student.
  - The Director, Physical Education should furnish the list of Sports/Games events approved by the National Federations / Associations and approved by the Kerala Sports Council and recommendations made only for approved events.
  - Application with all relevant documents and attested copies of certificates for Grace Grade Points shall be submitted to the Director of Physical Education of the University through the Principal/Director of Physical Education / HoD of Physical Education of the College concerned for verification. The Director of Physical Education of the University may send the approved list to the Controller of Examinations of the University for awarding Grace Grades.

Total Weight for Performance in Sports and Games = 15

Weighted Grade Point Average =  $\frac{\text{Total Cumulative WGP}}{\text{Total Weight}}$   
=  $\frac{20}{15} = 1.33$
