

Part I - Amendments made to the Kerala University First
Statutes, 1977

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Amendment No. 192

“That, the proviso to Statute 10 of Chapter 3 of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1977 may be substituted as follows:

Provided that the age of retirement of teachers of the University shall be 60 years and that the teachers of the University who complete the age of 60 years during the course of an academic year and whose date of birth is second July or thereafter shall continue in service till the last day of the month in which the academic year ends and subject to the other conditions under Rule 60 [c] Part I Kerala Service Rules”.

The Senate at its meeting held on 29th and 30th July, 2008 has adopted the above amendment.

The above amendment was assented to by the Chancellor on 29-08-2009 and shall come into force with effect from that date. (Notification No. Ac.L/S/2309/08 dated 31-08-2009)

Amendment No. 193

“That, in Statute 1 of Chapter 10 ‘Faculties’ of the Kerala University First Statutes 1977, item XI - Faculty of Ayurveda be renamed as Faculty of Ayurveda and Sidda”

Amendment No. 194

“That, in chapter 22 - Faculty of Ayurveda - of the Kerala University First Statutes 1977, the name of the Faculty be amended to read as Faculty of Ayurveda and Sidha”.

Adopted by the Senate at its meeting held on 11th and 12th August 2009.

The above amendments to Kerala University First Statutes 1977 were assented to by the Chancellor on 05-04-2010 and shall come into force with effect from that date. (Notification No. Ac.L/S/2405/2009 dated 22-4-2010)

Amendment No. 195

“That, in Chapter 2 of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1977, statute 5 (B) (iii) be substituted as follows:

“To accord sanction for expenditure including works upto a maximum of Rs. 1 lakh, where the following conditions are satisfied.

- (a) The work is one included in a scheme approved by the Syndicate.

(b) Funds have been provided in the University Budget”.

Amendment No. 196

“That, in Chapter 2 of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1977, statute 5(B) (viii) to be eliminated.

Amendment No. 197

“That, in Chapter 2 of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1977, statute 5(B) (ix) be substituted as follows.

“To Sanction re-appropriation of funds upto Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) from one major head to another, provided that such re-appropriation does not involve any recurring liability, that is a liability which extends beyond the financial year in question”.

Amendment No. 198

“That in Chapter 2 of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1977, statute 5(B) (xi) be added after 5(B) (x) as follows.

“To sanction provisional payment upto Rs. 10 lakhs”.

“That, in Chapter 37 under the heading “University Departments”, in statute 2(1) after item 33L, the following item shall be added.

“33 M. Department of computational Biology and Bio informatics”.

The above amendment to the Kerala University First Statutes, 1977 was assented to by the Chancellor on 27-05-2011 and shall come in to force with effect from that date. Notification No. Acad.L/S/2334/2008 dated 06-06-2011.

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Amendment No. 17

That, the following amendment be made to the Kerala University First Statutes in respect of Pension, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Insurance and Age of Retirement of members of the Non-teaching Staff in Private Colleges, is issued under Notification (II) No. 33357/B2/75A/H. Edn. dated 30-3-1976 : namely:-

In Statute (I) the words 'as amended from time to time' be added before the words 'shall mutatis mutandis'.

The above amendment to the Kerala University Pension Statutes 1976 was assented to by the Chancellor on 29-9-1989 and shall come into force with effect from that date.

(Adopted by the Senate at its meeting held on 26th July 1989. Notified vide University notification No. Acad. L/PS/16/90 dated 9th February 1990)

Amendment No. 18

"That, the following amendment be made to clause (1) Statute 3 of the Kerala University First Statutes in respect of Pension, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Insurance and age of Retirement of the members of the non-teaching staff of Private Colleges published in Notification II-No. 33357/B2/75-A/H. Edn. dated 30th March, 1976.

- (i) after the first proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided further that the date of retirement of the non-teaching staff other than Last Grade, who have opted to retire at the age of sixty years, shall take effect from the afternoon of the last day of the month in which they attain the age of sixty years".

- (ii) in the second proviso for the word "further" the word 'also' shall be substituted.

The above amendment to the Statutes was assented to by the Chancellor on 25-7-1990, and shall come into force from that date.

Amendment No. 19

That, in Statute 17 of Chapter III of the Kerala University First

Statutes, 1976, the following clause shall be inserted after clause (2), namely:

“3. “The Military Service of Private College teachers shall be reckoned as qualifying service to the extent provided under Part III Kerala Service Rules”.

The above amendment to the Kerala University Pension Statutes, 1976 was assented to by the Chancellor on 18-3-91 and shall come into force with effect from that date.

(Adopted by the Senate at its meeting held on 18th December 1990 Notified vide University, Notification No. Acad. L/PS/18/90 dtd. 25-3-91).

Amendment No. 20

That, the existing provision under Note; of Clause (4) of Statute 58, be numbered as ‘1’

Amendment No. 21

That, the following be incorporated as Note ‘2’ under clause (4) Statute 58 of Chapter V of the Kerala University First Statutes in respect of Pension, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Insurance and Age of Retirement of Teachers of Private Colleges:

“2. Payment of interest on the fund balance beyond a period of six months upto a period of one year and upto any period beyond one year may be authorized by the Director of Collegiate Education after he has personally satisfied that the delay in payment was occasioned by circumstances beyond the control of the subscriber or the person to whom such payment was to be made and in every such case, the administrative delay involved in the matter shall be fully investigated and actions, if any required, taken”.

The above amendments to the Kerala University Pension Statutes, 1976 were assented to by the Chancellor on 20-4-92 and shall come into force with effect from that date.

Amendment No. 22

That, the word ‘twenty’ occurring in Statute 72 (a) of Chapter V of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1976, be substituted by the word ‘fifteen’.

Amendment No. 23

That, in Statute 59 of Chapter V of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1976 after sub-clause (v), the following shall be added as sub clause. (vi)

- (vi) "Meeting the cost of consumer durables such as Television Video Cassette Player/Recorder, Washing Machine, Cooking Range, Geysers and Computers".

The above amendments to the Statutes were assented to by the Chancellor on 17-6-1999 and it shall come into force with effect from that date.

Amendment No. 24

That, the following Amendments be made to Chapter III of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1976 in respect of Pension, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Insurance and Age of Retirement of Teachers of Private Colleges.

"That, Statute 16, Chapter III of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1976 in respect of Pension, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Insurance and Age of Retirement of Teachers of Private Colleges, be substituted by the following:

"16 - Service up to the age of 60 years in the case of Chapter III 60 opted teachers to qualify for pension and gratuity".

The service of teachers in Private Colleges upto the age of 60 years in the case of Chapter III 60 opted teachers, shall qualify for pension and gratuity".

Amendment No. 25

"That, the sentence "The pension for each completed year of service shall be calculated at 1/120th of the average emolument subject to a maximum of 30/120th of the average emoluments" in Statute 19 Chapter III of the Kerala University First Statutes, 1976 in respect of Pension, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Insurance and Age of Retirement of teachers of Private Colleges, be substituted by the sentence.

"The amount of pension shall be determined on the basis of the pension formula evolved by the Government from time to time".

Amendment No. 26

That, the words, "the last 12 months immediately preceding the date on which he completes 55 years of Age occurring in explanations 2 and 3, forming part of Statute 19, Chapter III be substituted by the words 'the last 10 months' immediately preceding the date on which he retires from service".

Amendment No. 27

That, the figures '55' and '12' occurring in Explanation 5, forming part of Statute 19 Chapter III be substituted respectively by the figures '60' (in the case of Chapter III 60 opted teachers) and '10'.

As amended explanations 2, 3 and 5 will read thus:

'Explanation 2'.

The expression "average emoluments" in the case of a teacher means "the emoluments for a month calculated for the last 10 months immediately preceding the date on which he retires from service".

Explanation 3.

"In the case of a teacher who continues in service upto 60 years, the average emoluments shall be calculated on the basis of emoluments drawn during the last 10 months immediately proceeding the date on which he retires from service".

Explanation 5

"In the case of a teacher who retires voluntarily or otherwise before 60 years of age, the expression "average emoluments" for the purpose of calculating the pension under this Statute shall be emoluments for 10 months immediately preceding the date with effect from which he retires".

Amendment No. 28

That, the figure '55' occurring in explanation 2, forming part of Statute 20, Chapter III the Kerala University First Statutes, 1976 be substituted by the figure '60', (in the case of Chapter III 60 opted teachers).

Amendment No. 29

That, the figure '30' occurring in explanation 3, forming part of Statute 20, Chapter III the Kerala University First Statutes, 1976 be substituted by the figure '33'.

These amendments will be applicable only to Chapter III Opted Teachers.

“That, in Chapter 3-Conditions of Service of Members of Non-teaching Staff, of the Kerala University (Conditions of Service of Teachers and Members of Non-teaching Staff) First Statutes, 1979, the following be incorporated as clauses (14) and (15) under Statute 41-Qualification for appointments.

Posts	Qualifications
(14) Technical Assistant (Computer Science/BCA)	Any one of the following qualification is essential. i. PGDCA of University of Kerala/ Qualification equivalent thereto. ii. B. Sc. (Computer Science/BCA iii. A level certificate of DOEACC. iv. 3 year Diploma in Computer Engineering approved by Technical Education Department, Government of Kerala.

Experience:-

Desirable :- One year experience in Computer Programming or Computer Maintenance in any Government/Quasi Government Institution.

Explanation :- ‘Quasi-Government Institution’ is one which is either set up and/or under the control of the Government of Kerala or India, Universities/Aided Colleges and Schools, Autonomous Institutions under the control of the Government of India or the Government of Kerala.

(15) Technical Assistant (Electronics)

Essential: B. Sc. Electronics with one year experience or Diploma in Electronics or 3 year Diploma in Electronics approved by Technical Education Department, Government of Kerala.

Desirable : One year experience in the field.

The above amendment to the Kerala University First Statutes, 1979 was assented to by the Chancellor on 6-6-2005, and shall come into force with effect from that date.

Adopted by the Syndicate with the powers of the Senate as envisaged Under Section 23A of the Kerala University Act, 1974 at its

Meeting held on 27-11-2004. Notified Vide Notification No. Acad. L. CSS/624/2004 dated 14-6-2005)

Amendment No. 36

“That, in Statute 25 of Chapter 2 of the Kerala University (Conditions of Service of Teachers and Members of Non-teaching Staff) First Statutes, 1979, the following ‘Explanation’ be added after 25(2) as ‘Explanation-1’.

Explanation - 1 Leave without Allowances beyond 4 months to the Staff of Aided Colleges will be sanctioned by Government as is provided for in Rule 64 Part I KSR”.

- 40 (a) - Conditions of service of Teachers in unaided Colleges:
- (i) For making appointment of Teachers including Principal in unaided Colleges, the selection shall be made after giving due publicity.
 - (ii) Age : The maximum age for a teacher in the unaided College shall be sixty five (65) years.
 - (iii) Approval of appointment : Approval of every appointment to the teaching post in unaided Colleges shall be made by the Syndicate subject to satisfying the conditions specified in these Statutes.

Note : 1 All Teachers of Unaided Colleges affiliated to the University shall possess the qualifications prescribed in the Regulations relating to qualification of Teachers except the stipulation that they should pass the eligibility test for Lecturers

conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar tests accredited by the UGC.

Note : 2 Teachers who are having approved service in Affiliated Colleges shall be deemed to be qualified.

The above Amendment to the Kerala University First Statutes, 1979 was assented to by the Chancellor on 15-10-2005, and shall come into force with effect from that date.

29 Election Disputes: An election petition calling in question any election shall be made in writing. It shall be forwarded to the Vice-Chancellor with the prescribed fee remitted to the credit of the Kerala University Fund, so as to reach him within seven days of the declaration of the result of the election:

Fee Prescribed

- (i) Election to the Senate and the Syndicate Rs. 500/-
