**CIRCULAR**

The University Level Monitoring Committee (ULMC) has decided to instruct the Colleges/Centres of the University to strictly adhere to the following criteria for awarding the Continuous Evaluation (CE) Grades for all the First Degree Programmes under CBCS system.

- (i) For each Course, there should be at least two Class Tests during a Semester.
- (ii) The 1<sup>st</sup> Class Test should be conducted with a weight – '15' and 2<sup>nd</sup> with a weight '30'.
- (iii) The Grade Points secured by the candidates for the two Class Tests should not be rounded off separately.
- (iv) While taking the average of the Grade Points of the two Class Tests, the Grade Points should not be rounded off.

Hence the Department Committee of the Colleges/Centres of the University are directed that the above recommendation of the ULMC shall strictly be adhered to.
