The two day national conference is likely to discuss and debate on the world famous Indian scholar Abul Hasan Ali Hasni Nadwi with special focus on his worldly renowned and widely acclaimed work entitled "ماذا خسر العالم بانحطاط المسلمين" (What the World Lost with the Decline of Muslims).¹

The 20th century Muslim India has witnessed emergence of a good number of great Islamic scholars and intellectuals who preached the Indian society with their eloquent style and profound knowledge and penned down many books of world reputation. Abul Hasan Ali Nadwi is placed at the top of this group for his valuable contributions and intellectual presentations.

Maulana Syed Abul Hasan Ali Nadwi was indisputably one of the greatest exponents of Islam in the Second half of the 20th century and because of his command over Arabic, through his writings and speeches, he had a wide area of influence extending far beyond the Sub-continent, particularly in the Arab world. His exposition of Islam was marked by moderation.

The book which is likely to be at the core of debate in the conference, crystalizes the issue of decline of Muslims with factual findings. It covers a wide range of areas, including Europe and materialism, rising of Islamic world and European colonialism and morality, for fixing and analyzing the problem.
