

Guidelines for awarding Grace Grade for Sports Performance / Arts/NSS/NCC from the Academic Year 2010-2011.

1. The award of Grade Point for meritorious candidates is divided into 5 categories namely A, B,C,D & E. The maximum Grade Points that may be awarded to a student in a particular year for highest performance may be limited to 30 WGP. Further a limit of Cumulative WGP upto each category is also suggested so that justice is done for higher performance.
2. In case of both semester courses and annual courses, the academic year may be taken from 1st June to 31st May.
3. Grace Credit Points and corresponding WGPA should be distributed either in a semester or among the 2 semesters in an academic year as the calendar of Association of Indian Universities Competitions are held on a yearly basis.
4. The student shall claim the Grace Credit Points within 6 months after the end of the academic year.
5. Grace Credit Points and WGPA can be used for additional chance / repeat of semester and for readmitted / N + 1 candidate as per AIU Guidelines.
6. The WGPA obtained by the student may be distributed to courses in a semester or among two semesters according to the choice of the student.
7. The Director, Physical Education should furnish the list of Sports/Games events approved by the National Federations / Associations and approved by the Kerala Sports Council and recommendations made only for approved events.
8. Deaf and Dumb candidates with disability of 40% or above on production of a Medical Certificate obtained from a Medical Board are only eligible to receive the Credit Points and WGPA for Sports performance.
9. Application with all relevant documents and attested copies of certificates for Grace Grade Points shall be submitted to the Director of Physical Education of the University through the Principal/Director of Physical Education / HoD of Physical Education of the College concerned for verification. The Director of Physical Education of the University may send the approved list to the Controller of Examinations of the University for awarding Grace Grades.
10. In the case of NCC Cadets application with all relevant documents and attested copies of certificates for Grace Grade shall be submitted through the Group Commander, NCC Group by the institution and forwarded to the Controller of Examinations after proper recommendations of eligible Grades.
11. In the case of Arts / NSS participants, the Director of Students Services shall finalise the list of eligible students for Grace Grades after collecting the applications with all relevant documents from the Principals and forward the recommendations to the Controller of Examinations every year.

Grace Grade Points can be granted as shown in the example given below:

If the Cumulative WGP of a candidate is 20, for performance in Sports and Games

$$\text{Then Grace Grade Points of the candidate} = \frac{\text{Cumulative WGP}}{\text{Total weight for performance}} = \frac{20}{15} = 1.33$$

The Grace Grade Points obtained by a student can be distributed to the ESE of different Courses, as per the choice of the student.
