Classification: (i) First Class with Distinction: CGPA 7.5 or above; (ii) First Class: CGPA 6 or above & less than 7.5 [Applicable only for candidates passing all the subjects of eight semesters within five academic years (ten consecutive semesters after the commencement of his/her course of study)]. (iii) Second Class: All other successful candidates who passed the B.Tech Degree Examinations.
3. Grade Point Average (GPA) =  $[\sum(\text{Credit} \times \text{Marks earned for the subject} / \text{Maximum Marks for the Subject}) / \sum \text{Credits}] \times 10$

## **GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING THE TRANSCRIPT OF MARKS**

1. Entries pertaining to Name of Applicant , Programme, Month & Year of Exam, Exam. Code, Candidate Code, Class are to be shown as that given in the Provisional Certificate.
2. Exam Code: Candidates who cleared B.Tech in Semester Eight should mention the exam code of the 8<sup>th</sup> semester (eg: 41203807). In cases where the last appeared examination for course clearance is not 8<sup>th</sup> semester, the Exam code of the last appearance must be included along with the semester eight exam code (eg: 41203807/41203708).
3. Duration of the Course should contain the number of Semesters, the number of years and period of study [for eg: Eight Semesters( 4 years ), 2006-2010]  
In case of Lateral Entry it shall be Six Semesters ( 3 Years ), 2007-2010 with a superscription ( B.Tech Degree – Lateral Entry ).
4. Institution shall be name of College where the applicant studied for the programme.
5. CGPA: For those whom CGPA is not applicable (prior to 2003 scheme), can substitute with Cumulative Total Mark (and can omit CGPA in the explanation box).CGPA should be mentioned as per the eg. given below.

6. In the tables, 'A' to be marked for Absent and 'NA' to be marked in all blank cells.
7. Only the highest mark scored in improvement / supplementary examination (if appeared) need to be mentioned in the "Imp./Sup." column.
8. The Exam Code and Month & Year of all examinations taken by the Candidate are to be included in the respective tables of semesters in the order of their appearances.
9. Transcript of marks should be prepared on Legal or Folio size paper (**on both sides in a single sheet**). One extra copy of the Transcript of Marks is to be submitted for office use in addition to required number of transcripts.
10. Attested photocopies of mark lists of every appearance in each semester and attested photocopy of Degree or Provisional certificate if obtained are to be submitted along with the application and fee receipt.
11. The fee for issue of the transcript of marks is Rs. 1000/- per copy (subject to change).
