ITEM No.03.05.01 Setting up of Air – conditioned e-library at International Centre for Marxian Studies and Research – Revised proposal – approval of – reg.

The Budget Speech 2021-22 (Item no 88) allotted an amount of ₹25,00,000/- to expand the International Centre For Marxian Studies & Research (ICMSR). Subsequently, sanction was accorded to release an amount of ₹25,00,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Lakh only) as Provisional Advance in installments as and when required to develop the ICMSR to Dr. Nithya N R, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science and Joint Director i/c, ICMSR. A provisional advance of ₹9,00,000/-was released to Dr. Nithya NR for the first phase development of ICMSR(currently in the process of regularization).

Further, the Syndicate held on 25.05.2022, vide item No.42.47.01, approved the proposal submitted by the Director, ICMSR for setting up of an Air Conditioned E-Library at ICMSR amounting to ₹16,00,000/-(Rupees Sixteen Lakh only).

Later, the Director, ICMSR, submitted a revised proposal for ₹14,85,777/- with variations in the components, towards the setting up of an Air-Conditioned e-library at ICMSR. ITEM No. 03.05.03 University Institute of Technology (UIT), Malayinkeezhu- Acquisition of land/building for the UIT- reg.

[Ad AVII]

The Syndicate at its meeting held on 20.05.2023, vide item No 57.92.16, considered the matter pertaining to the proposals for acquiring land for UIT Malayinkeezhu and resolved to entrust Sri. B P Murali, Member, Syndicate to inspect the proposed sites for the UIT and submit a report. The Syndicate, vide item no.57.90 considered the report on status of the infrastructural facilities of UITs in connection the compliance of the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court in the WP(c) No. 13584/2022 and resolved to entrust Sri. B P Murali and Prof. K Lalitha, Members, Syndicate to study and recommend further course of action to be taken in respect of UIT Malayinkeezhu.

The Syndicate at its meeting held on 09.06.2023, vide item no 58.66, considered the report of the afore said sub-committee, recommending to continue the UIT at the present building till the completion and handing over of the building constructing using MLA Fund, at Vilavoorkal Panchayath. The Syndicate at the meeting held on 09.06.2023, vide item no.58.66, resolved to accept the report and include the UIT in the admission portal for the academic year 2023-2024. Further resolved to inform the principal of the UIT to initiate action based on the report within three months failing which the UIT shall be removed from the admission portal for the next academic year.

In this connection, it may also be noted on the basis of the request of the Principal, UIT Malayinkeezhu dated 14.03.2023, regarding the offer of 26 cents of land by Sree Bhagavathi Temple Trust, Kuzhakkad, the Estate Officer visited the site and reported that the land is suitable for the UIT, but insisted that the report from the Engineering unit may also be sought regarding the suitability of the land for the construction of building for UIT and also to give direction to the Principal to obtain documents related to the possession of the land.

In the meantime, Adv.I.B Satheesh MLA proposed to provide 15 cents of land from Vilavoorkkal Panchayath, as a result of his endeavour to get a suitable land for the UIT and apprised that administrative sanction has been sought for construction of 3500 sq ft building utilizing Rs.1 crore from MLA development fund.

On the other hand, the Principal has reported that the PTA Executive and Staff Council have decided to request the University to take necessary steps to acquire the 26 cents of land at Kuzhakkad, as they find the site more suitable for the smooth functioning of the UIT and further developments is possible than the proposed site at Vilavoorkkal.

Now, in reply to the direction given to comply with the resolution of the Syndicate, vide item no 58.66, the Principal has reported that Adv. I B Satheesh, MLA had conveyed them to ascertain a suitable date for the foundation stone laying ceremony of the new proposed building at Vilavoorkkal Panchayath, in consultation with the office of the Registrar.

As ordered by the Vice Chancellor, the matter of identifying land suitable for construction of building for UIT, from among the two options available, and the matter of whether to proceed with the foundation stone laying ceremony on the land proposed by the MLA, are placed before the Standing Committee of the Syndicate for consideration and recommendation.

- Smt.Smitha S was engaged as Lecturer in Commerce on contract at UIT, Pirappancode for the period from 09.06.2022 to 08.05.2023, vide UO.No.6038/Ad.AVII/2022/UOK dated 06.08.2022.
- During this contract period, she was granted Leave without remuneration on medical grounds for the period from 27.07.2022 to 27.10.2022 and extended LWR upto 28.02.2023 for the pregnancy treatment (Office Order No.12341/Adm.AVII/2021/UOK dated 01.12.2022). But, she did not join duty after the leave.
- The Syndicate, vide item no.56.57, resolved to engage Smt. Smitha S as Lecturer in Commerce at UIT Pirappancode for one more term on the basis of the performance appraisal. She was intimated to be engaged for the period from 10.05.2023 to 02.04.2024, vide memo no. 19867/Adm A VII/2021/UOK(2) dated 06.05.2023.
- The Principal, vide letter dated 10.05.2023, has forwarded a medical certificate in respect of Smt.Smitha S with regard to her postpartum treatment and informed that she has not joined for duty.
- The Principal, vide letter dated 22.05.2023 forwarded the employment contract w.e.f. 22.05.2023 in respect of Smt.Smitha S, along with her joining report.

The Principal, UIT, Kanjiramkulam, vide Letter No. UIT/KJM/064/023 dated 12.06.23 informed that the centre is presently working in the first floor of the Marketing Complex, Grama Panchayath, Kanjiramkulam. A building "St.Helen's Nursery School"(Old building) which is under the custody of the Superior, Convent of the Lady of Lords, Lourdipuram, Kanjiramkulam P O was taken for functioning the centre from 03.06.2023. This building was suggested and recommended by the President, Grama Panchayath and Members, Syndicate. The newly selected building has sufficient room facilities to accommodate present batches of the centre. Rent of the building is ₹5,000/- per month. An amount of Rs.1,65,000/- is required for constructing toilets, electrification works, setting of Computer Lab and to meet shifting expenses.

Hence, he requested to grant permission to withdraw the proposed amount from the PTA account and also make provisions for paying the rent of Rs.5000/- per month.

The following facts be noted in this regard.

- Steps have already been initiated to hand over 17 cents of land under the ownership of Kanjiramkulam, Gramapanchayath in the name of Registrar for constructing new building for the centre.
- In the meanwhile, the Members, Syndicate visited UIT, Kanjiramkulam on 31.05.2023 and reported that, 'they held talk with the authorities of Local bodies and the Authorities assured that 1. new land for UIT is found out and the Members of the Legislative Assembly has assured to build a new building at the proposed site. 2.Until then, the present centre may be shifted to a new convenient site and measures are taken by them for the purpose. Under this circumstances, the centre be continued for one more year.'
- The report was considered by the Syndicate in its meeting held on 09.06.2023, vide item no.58.66 and as per its resolution the Principal was intimated to initiate action based on the report within 3 months, if not the institution will be removed from the admission portal for the next academic year (vide letter No.Ad A VII.9405/2017 dated 22.06.2023).
- As per the resolution of the Syndicate held on 27.06.2023, vide item no.59.127.13, admission to UIT, Kanjiramkulam for the academic year 2023-24 was stopped. (U.O.No.2307/Adm A VII/2021/UOK dtd 13.07.23).
- The Principal has not informed of their decision to take a new building (on rent) for the functioning of UIT. Further more, without getting prior permission of the University, the Principal has executed rent agreement (03.06.2023) with the owner of the building and has forwarded the Minutes of the PTA Executive Committee (dated 08.06.2023) in which they have taken decision to take the abovesaid building on rent.
- As per the orders of the Registrar, explanation was sought from the Principal for having rented the building without intimation/ prior sanction of the University.
- In reply, the Principal has informed that "Sri.Rajendrakumar P and Prof.K.Lalitha, the former Syndicate Members, in the PTA Gneral body meeting held on 07.10.2022 discussed with Sri. M. Vincent, MLA about different measures to improve the infrastructure facilities of the centre and suggested to shift the centre to another building with more facilities. The visited St.Helen's Nursery School building and again made discussion with the President, Gramapanchayath, Kanjiramkulam, etc. Further, the Syndicate Members & the President Gramapanchayath orally instructed the Principal to shift the centre from the present building to the building of St.Helen's Nursery school. Based on this, he was executed rent agreement with the authorities of school on 03.06.23 and the same was intimated to the University on 12.06.23."

The Vice-Chancellor has ordered to place the matter before the Standing Committee of the Syndicate.

In obedience to the orders of the Vice-Chancellor, the matter is placed before the Standing Committee on the Syndicate for consideration.

Recommendation:

• To hear the Principal, UIT, Kanjiramkulam in the next meeting of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate.

State Plan Grant - Financial Constraints - Reprioritization of the pending bills in Cash Section so as to limit the expenditure to the available balance amount and issuance of Circular - Consideration of:-

A Meeting to discuss the Financial Constraints in connection with the Implementation of various Scheme-components under State Plan Grant 2023-24 was held on 18.08.2023 at Registrar's Chamber.

The Concerned Section has briefed about the current financial constraints and informed that only an amount of Rs. 4 Crore has been released by the Government towards the first instalment of State Plan Grant for the year 2023-24 vide G O dated 04.08.23. It was also informed that bills

amounting to Rs. 12 Crores (including Rs. 4,84,03,367 for Priority 1 Bills) are currently pending in Cash Section and an appropriate administrative decision is needed for priortizing the aforementioned bills for payment due.

It was informed by the Finance Officer that an amount of Rs. 3.91 Cores is available against the pending bills. It was also informed that Rs.50 Lakh which was earlier released to Dr.A.Gangaprasad, towards the implementation of Specific Project under State Plan Grant 2019-20 was refunded to the KUF and is available for disbursal.

The Finance Officer has suggested to reprioritize the pending bills so as to limit the expenditure to the available Rs. 4.41 Crores.

The Meeting, chaired by the Registrar, has recommended the following:

- (1) to reprioritize the pending bills in Cash Section so as to limit the expenditure to the available balance amount.
- (2) Strict instructions may be given to Heads/Hon. Directors of Departments/Centres and concerned Sections, that prior sanction may be obtained before effecting Purchases (including Equipments, Furniture and Books & Journals) from State Plan Grant, considering that Plan expenditure is subject to availability of funds, as already stipulated in the Budget Estimate for the year 2023-24. A Circular may be issued immediately in this regard.
- (3) in the wake of financial constraints, priority may be given to clear the pending bills. Issuance of University Order with regard to new projects/Purchases may be done only after ascertaining financial condition after the first two instalments of State Plan Grant for the year 2023-24.
- (4) If financial condition has not improved, fresh Proposals for the year 2024-25 may not be invited. Instead, the feasibility of resubmitting the Annual Plan Proposals of the University 2023-24 by enhancing amounts under relevant Scheme-components such as 'Ongoing Projects/Purchases', may be explored.
- (5) to place the recommendations no. (1), (2) and (4) to the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Finance.

The Vice-Chancellor has approved the Minutes of the aforementioned Minutes of the Meeting. In this context, the following proposals are placed before the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Finance for consideration and recommendation.

- (1) the pending bills in Cash Section (including Priority 1 Bills amounting to Rs. 4,79,03,367/-) may be reprioritized so as to limit the expenditure to the available balance amount of Rs. 4.41 Crores (the Detailed list of Priority 1 Bills are attached).
- (2) Strict instructions may be given to Heads/Hon. Directors of Departments/Centres and concerned Sections, that prior sanction may be obtained before effecting Purchases (including various Equipments, Furniture and Books & Journals) from State Plan Grant, considering that Plan expenditure is subject to availability of funds, as already stipulated in the Budget Estimate for the year 2023-24. A Circular may be issued in this regard.
- (3) If financial condition has not improved, fresh Proposals for the year 2024-25 may not be invited. About the Programme on BA Hons. (Politics & International Relations/ Economics/ History) with research This programme is launched in recognition of the requirement to strengthen undergraduate education. The curricula of the programme can equip students with the knowledge base, intellectual abilities, multidisciplinary perspectives, flexible skill sets, basic expertise, social commitment and research aptitude that will make them responsible citizens in a knowledge society and offer them multiple career and employment options.

BA Hons. (Politics & International Relations/ Economics/ History) with research is a four year UG programme to be offered by the University of Kerala commencing from the academic year 2023-24. The programme offers major in Politics & International Relations/ Economics/ History with focus research. The programme will have two Broad Pathways, (a) 3 year UG Degree and (b) 4 year UG Degree (Honours with Research). The course will have four major components- (1) Foundational Courses grouped into 4 major baskets as Ability Enhancement courses (AEC) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) Value Addition Courses (VAC) and Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC), (2) Discipline Specific Major (3) Discipline Specific/Multidisciplinary Minor and (4) Research Component with internship and field surveys. Students who choose to exit after 3 years shall be awarded UG Degree in their respective Major Discipline after the successful completion of the required minimum of Courses of credits.  - Dr. Josukutty C A (Convenor)
- 5. The curriculum shall be in accordance with the present academic regulations of the University of Kerala in the light of regulations framed by Kerala State Higher Education Council/ Department, Government of Kerala.
- 6. The Committee requested the IQAC of the University to coordinate the curriculum design activities.
- 7. The committee suggested Dr. Girish Kumar R, Head, Department of Political Science as the coordinator for the programme, commencing in the academic year 2023-24.
- 8. The committee recommended the University to fix the intake for the programme as 25.
- 9. Regarding the teaching of the programme, the committee recommended the University to assign it to Contract/Guest/Visiting/Emeritus/Retired Professors, till regular appointments are made. The service of those regular faculty members, in the teaching and research departments of University of Kerala, willing to engage the courses can also be utilized. It is also suggested to appoint one Emeritus Professor each in Economics and History.
- 10. The committee proposed a tuition fee of Rs.10000/-per semester. All other fees shall be in par with that of conventional Postgraduate programmes in the teaching departments of University of Kerala.
- 11. It is proposed to notify the programme at the earliest.

- 12. It is suggested to admit the candidates for the programme commencing in the academic year 2023-24, based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations, with necessary normalization. It is also proposed to conduct an entrance examination from the next academic year onwards.
- 13. The committee recommended to admit the candidates by following the existing reservation system prevailing in the university teaching departments.
- 14. The committee recommended to initiate urgent steps for providing necessary infrastructure to the Political Science department for starting the programme.
- 15. The rules for all the evaluation procedures of this programme will be framed and implemented by CSS.

- i. The Officials/Faculty members should desist from any act of discrimination against SC/ST/OBC students on grounds of their social origin.
 - /Institute may develop a page on their website for lodging such complaints
- ii. The University of caste discrimination by SC/ST/OBC students and also place a complaint register in the Registrar's/Principal's Office for the purpose. If any such incident comes to the notice of the authorities, action should be taken against the erring official/faculty members promptly.
- iii. The colleges should ensure that no official/faculty members indulge in any kind of discrimination against any community or category of students.
- iv. The University may constitute a committee to look into the complaints of discrimination received from SC/ST/OBC students/Teachers and non teaching staff. The committee shall also include members belonging to SC/ST/OBC category .

Based on the previous letters from UGC, University has already instituted a webpage for lodging complaints of caste discrimination against SC/ST students and it was extended to include OBC students also. A committee was also constituted for looking into the complaints of caste based discrimination. Heeding to the latest direction from UGC, as per the orders of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Subject to reporting to the Syndicate the following action has been taken.

- 1. OBC Category has been included in the Complaint Register maintained in the Office of the Registrar for registering complaints regarding caste based discrimination by SC/ST students.
- 2. A Circular incorporating all latest direction from UGC has been issued. (Circular No.46893/Admn AV/2023/UOK dated 10.08.2023)
- 3. All affiliated colleges has been directed to comply with the latest direction of UGC to prevent Caste based discrimination in their institutions.

The matter is therefore reported to the Syndicate.
