Indian Sociological Society (ISS)



The workshop is conceived in the background of a perceived lacuna in social research among the research community. The more fundamental issue is the unfamiliarity with the underlying paradigms in social research for the quantitative and qualitative researches. Both involve different strategies with different philosophical and epistemological basis. Further, inadequacy in qualitative research is an Achilles heel, particularly for research scholars and young teachers. In addition, academic writing and publishing is an area that has been neglected in the academic circles and hence the youngsters seem to lack required ability and skill in writing and publishing research works. It is more so in qualitative research, as qualitative research deals with more narrations and descriptions than numbers and measurements. It is a fact that youngsters in the academia are not very familiar with the technicalities and the procedures of publishing academic articles and review of books/articles. The proposed workshop jointly organized by the Department of Sociology on the occasion of its Golden Jubilee and Indian Sociological Society (ISS), the prestigious academic body of Sociologists in India and abroad, seeks to address these twin inadequacies.
