The focus of the seminar on translating laboratory ideas into business aligns perfectly with national goals of bio-economy growth and fostering self-reliance in the biotech sector.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- ❖ The abstract (font - Times New Roman) should comprise the following:
 - ❖ Title of the presentation (bold font, size 14)
 - ❖ Designation and affiliation of all the authors (font size -12): Full name of all authors with their affiliation (name of the presenting author should be underlined), and email address of presenting and corresponding authors
 - ❖ Matter: A brief description of not more than 250 words typed in Times New Roman (font size 12), with 1.5 line spacing and 1" margin on all sides. A maximum of five keywords should be included at the end of the abstract (bold font, size 12)
- ❖ The abstract will be reviewed by the Scrutiny Committee and the authors of the approved abstracts shall be intimated. The decision of the committee shall be final and binding

Keynote & Plenary Talks: The Seminar promises to provide a heightened academic experience through keynote and plenary lectures by eminent scientists in the areas of biotechnology, drawn from across the world. The event would provide a worthy learning experience for students and researchers.

- ❖ All research papers shall be original, unpublished and plagiarism-free
- ❖ Selected papers will be published on the first day of the seminar in the form of a book with ISBN number
- ❖ The papers shall be thematic, with relevant research questions.
- ❖ The research papers shall not exceed 5000 words
- ❖ The papers are required to be typed in Times New Roman, with font size 12, on A4 size with 1" margin on all sides and 1.5 line spacing and submitted in MS Word format.
- ❖ Other relevant details will be intimated once selected for full paper submission

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

❖ Presentation - 7 min; Discussion - 3 min

POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- ❖ Title of the paper, name(s) of the author(s) and affiliation(s) on top.
- ❖ **Poster (36" X 48") must be submitted in PDF format**
- ❖ Text: Ensure readability of the contents of the poster.
 - ❖ Language - ENGLISH only
- ❖ Illustrations: Poster should contain static photographs only, with no video or animation
- ❖ The posters will be evaluated by a panel of experts
