O R D E R

On the recommendation of the Standing Committee
on Finance, the Syndicate at its meeting held on 20-3-1997
has approved the following norms for sanctioning Special
Financial Assistance to SC/ST Research Scholars, for which
provision has been made in the budget of the University.

1. The Special Financial Assistance, limited to Rs.10,000/-
to a Research Scholar, may be granted to 20 eligible
applicants every year for purchase of books, stationery
and typing. The amount may be granted in three instal-
ments of Rs.4000/- for purchase of books, Rs.3000/- for
stationery and Rs.3000/- for meeting the typing charges
2. Applications in prescribed form may be invited by the
University during each academic year.
3. Eligibility for the grant may be restricted to SC/ST
candidates who are engaged in full-time research under
research guides approved by the University of Kerala,
in affiliated colleges, Kerala University Departments
and other research institutions approved by the
University of Kerala.
4. The financial assistance may be restricted to those
belonging to the State of Kerala.

5. The assistance may be granted for scientific research grants, fellowships etc. only by the applicant.
6. Applications with all supporting documents may be forwarded to the Head of the Department with the recommendation of the research guide.
7. Those who have submitted the Ph.D. thesis may not be made eligible.
8. The grant may be sanctioned only once by a research scholar during his/her period of research.
9. A bond in a stamped paper worth Rs.50/- may be executed by the recipient to the grant. In the event of the recipient not submitting the thesis within a period of five years from the date of receipt of the financial assistance, the full amount will be refunded to the KMC.
10. Selection may be made based on merit considering the following:
 - M.Phil degree recognised by the university
 - Seniority based on the date of registration for Ph.D
 - Marks scored at the P.G. level in the relevant subject
 - Additional academic qualifications
 - Published work in a recognised journal
 - Teaching experience at College/School level
11. The applicant should furnish the following documents along with the application.
 - (1) Proof of Community/Caste (Attested copy of the S.S.L.C. is sufficient).
 - (2) Copy of the University Order granting registration for Ph.D
 - (3) Recommendation from the research guide
 - (4) Attested copies of certificates and marklists.

12. The amount may be drawn and disbursed by the Registrar/Head of the Department concerned on the strength of the specific P.O. issued in this regard.

The above terms will be effective from the academic year 1976-77 onwards.

ORDER

As per the University order read as (1) above, the Special Financial Assistance, limited to Rs.10,000/- to a Research Scholar, was granted to 20 eligible SC/ST applicants, who are engaged in full time research in University Departments, affiliated colleges and other research institutions approved by the University, every year.

In *Clause 10* of the U.O., selection is based on merit considering the following.

- M.Phil degree recognized by the University of Kerala,
- Seniority based on the date of registration for Ph.D.
- Marks scored at the P.G Level in the relevant subject.
- Additional Academic qualifications.
- Published work in a recognized journal.
- Teaching experience at college/ school level.

The U.O doesn't specify the weightages to be assigned to for each of the criteria mentioned above for ranking the candidates, in cases where the number of eligible applicants exceeds the number of permissible slots (20).

On the basis of the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Academic & Research, the Syndicate vide paper read as (3) above, has approved the following norms for ranking the applicants by assigning weightage for each of the criteria specified in the existing norms for granting the Special Financial Assistance to SC/ST research scholars.

1. Total score be fixed as 60 in which each of the six criteria be assigned a maximum score of 10 points.
2. Those having M.Phil Degree recognized by the University of Kerala be given weightage of 10 points.

3. In the case of seniority of PhD registration, for each of the completed year of seniority :
PhD registration, as on the date of notification, a weightage of 2 points be given s^{ubject} to a maximum of 10.
4. The percentage of marks in PG Degree be converted to the scale of 10.
5. Each additional qualification be given the weightage of 2 points subject to a maximum of 10 (Here, NET & JRF may be considered as single entity in ranking).
6. Each published work in recognised journal be given weightage of 2 points subject to a maximum of 10.
7. For each completed year of teaching experience in college/school level, as on the date of notification, weightage of 2 points be given subject to a maximum of 10.

The above norms will be effective from the academic year 2014 – 15 onwards.

The U.O read as (1) above stands modified to this extent.


