ORDER

The Chairperson, Board of Studies in Commerce (PG), proposed to convene a meeting of the Board of Studies vide paper read as(1) above to discuss and finalise the revised curriculum for the Income Tax courses in M.Com Programme in accordance with the provisions of the new Income Tax Act, 2025.

The Board of Studies vide paper read as (2) above discussed the need to include the provisions of the Income tax Act 2025 in the course on Income tax for the M.Com Programme with effect from the current academic year,as the same was made effective from April 2026. The curriculum need to include the provisions of the new Act. All assessment processes (Continuous assessment and End Semester Examination) need to consider the same.

The Board of Studies in Commerce (PG) unanimously recommended that the Income tax courses for M.Com programme to be aligned with the provisions of the Income Tax Act 2025 which became effective from April 2026.

The Minutes of the meeting of Board of Studies in Commerce (PG) was approved by the Chairperson, Board of Studies in Commerce (PG) and endorsed by the Dean, Faculty of Commerce.

The Academic Council vide paper read as(3) resolved to to align the Income Tax courses of the M.Com Programme with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 2025.
