ORDER

The revised Regulations, Scheme and Syllabus of First Semester of Two year M.Ed Curriculum for affiliated Colleges was implemented from the Academic year 2018-19 vide U.O read as (1) above.

The combined meeting of Board of studies in Education (PG) and the Faculty of Education vide paper read (2) above recommended to approve the Syllabus of Second to Fourth Semesters and to effect certain modifications in the Regulations and Scheme of revised Two year M.Ed Curriculum implemented from the Academic year 2018.

The Vice Chancellor subject to reporting to the Academic Council approved the Syllabus of Second to Fourth Semesters and the modifications made in the Regulations and Scheme of revised Two year M.Ed Curriculum.

The modifications in the Regulations and Scheme are detailed below.

5	j)	In case a candidate gets minimum for all papers(40%) but fails to get semester minimum(50%) she/he has to re-appear for <u>all papers</u> to secure a pass in that semester.	In case a candidate gets minimum for all papers(40%) but fails to get semester minimum(50%) she/he has to re-appear for <u>those paper/papers which does not have aggregate 50% for theory and CE taken together</u> to secure a pass in that semester.
